- Population: Disabled homeless persons (priority is chronically homeless persons)
- Access: Through Community Intake Center
- Amount: \$736,854
- Term: 1 year (renewable)
- Funding source: Reallocation

2. 5th Street II

- Recipient: City of Winston-Salem
- Subrecipient: Experiment in Self-Reliance
- Type: Permanent Supportive Housing

- Population: Disabled homeless persons (priority is chronically homeless persons)
