Purpose and scope of this RFP: The Forsyth County Law Enforcement Detention Center (LEDC) houses a maximum capacity of approximately 1,000 inmates. Three meals per day are served for inmates and staff. The facility’s kitchen is scheduled to undergo renovations beginning around July 1, 2017 and are projected to take approximately 4 months. During the renovation, a temporary kitchen will be required to maintain food service for inmates and staff. Proposers should reference the attached appendices to construct their Proposal.
