

RE-ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Three bids were not received on July 28 as required by North Carolina bidding law, so this project is being re-advertised.

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143-129, sealed bid proposals endorsed “**W.L.G.C. Bunker & Cart Path Renovations - FB1813**” will be received by the City/County Purchasing Department, 324 City Hall, 101 N. Main Street, Winston-Salem, NC in Room 16 until **2:00 PM, August 15, 2017**, when all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. It is the bidder’s responsibility to ensure their bid proposal is received prior to the deadline. The City reserves the right to waive any informalities and to reject any or all proposals.

The awarded contractor must be properly licensed as required by Chapter 87 of the N.C. General Statutes to perform the work as general contractor.

General Scope of this work includes, but is not limited to: construction including: replacement of asphalt cart path sections, concrete curbing, storm drainage, timber steps and fencing, as well as site work including: erosion control, minor grading, landscaping, sodding as specified and shown on drawings.

This is a single prime bid. Bids shall be on a lump sum basis, with bid allowances as indicated in the Bidding Documents. A Bid Guarantee shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Compliance with the City of Winston-Salem’s Minority and Women Business Enterprise program is required on this project. Please refer to the Special Instructions to Bidders contained in the Bidding Documents. **It is MANDATORY that a completed and signed copy of the Identification of Minority Participation and Affidavit "A" Listing of Good Faith Efforts be included with the bidder's proposal.** The M/WBE subcontracting goals are 7% MBE and 5% WBE.
