# We are now in the 2011 National Electrical Code

As many of you know, the 2011 edition of the NC Electrical Code was approved by the Building Code Council and the Office of Administrative Hearing, but then referred to legislative review. In accordance with General Statute 150B, it then does not go into effect until after 30 legislative days or the end of the legislative session unless a bill is drafted to otherwise address the code. This legislative session ended on July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2012.

Due to the flurry of last minute changes to many bills in the closing hours of the session, our office could not confirm that a change was not implemented until the text of all changes appeared on-line.

Since it appears that no bill included it, the 2011 NC Electrical Code went into effect on Tuesday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2012.

All permits acquired after AP# 209343 will be inspected by the 2011 NEC.

We will try to accommodate AM and PM inspections, only when workload allows the personnel present on that given day will allow us to give that service. With the gas prices soaring and reduction in work force, we can no long guarantee this practice.

HVAC Change outs, make sure that the air handler is identified with the ampacity of the unit installed. If the mechanical and electrical permit is for an air conditioner only and there are fuses or panel outside and the electrical inspector does not have to go inside the dwelling please state this on the inspection notice. This will save time and we will not need to set up appointments with the homeowner.
