My signature hereto signifies I am the owner/financially responsible party for job site compliance with the Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance as outlined in Section V of the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO). I hereby acknowledge that Best Management Practices must be used to control soil erosion on my job site to include but not be limited to the following:

1. Installation and regular maintenance of silt fencing using the preferred method of trenching installation on all low/down slope sides of my job site. Silt fence is to have an upslope return at each end no less than 5 feet; and
2. Installation and regular maintenance of a stone construction entrance. Stone construction entrance shall consist of a 2 inch to 3 inch coarse aggregate stone. Construction entrance shall be a minimum of 6 inches in thickness, 12 foot wide and extend to the structure or a minimum of 50 feet in length; and
3. Removal of mud and sediment from the street or adjacent property(ies) immediately following such an occurrence; and
4. Conduct no land disturbing activity within 15 feet of the banks of streams, lakes, wetlands or other water course or water body; and
5. Provide temporary vegetation and/or mulch on any exposed areas to provide an effective barrier from erosion; and
6. Install any other measures as deemed necessary by the Erosion Control Inspections Program.
7. **Beginning January 1, 2013**, all sediment (silt) fence installation will be required to meet the minimum standards as specified in the NC Erosion and Sediment Control Planning and Design Manual Section 6.62 (link: http://portal.ncdenr.org/c/document_library/get_file?uuid=c426b29c-d395-4d8a-9fd2-de37a9366346&groupId=38334).

I understand that if the disturbed area for any reason becomes greater than 20,000 square feet, a formal Erosion Control Plan will be required to be submitted with proper fee for review, approval and permitting. I further acknowledge the City Inspection's staff may refuse to make building inspections and the Department of Stormwater/Erosion and Sedimentation Control may issue Notices of Violation, Stop Work Orders and/or Civil Penalties for failure to comply with Erosion Control Requirements.
