

Population Estimates, Forsyth County and Communities, July 2015

Forsyth County is North Carolina's 4<sup>th</sup> most populous county, with the City of Winston-Salem the 5<sup>th</sup> most populated municipality in the state. The population of Forsyth County was 369,019 in 2015, representing an average growth rate of 1.0% since 2010. This growth is equivalent to an additional 3,670 people per year, 1,980 (54%) of which are the result of net migration (in-migration minus out-migration) and 1,688 (46%) are the result of natural growth (births minus deaths). The City of Winston-Salem's 2015 population of 241,218 represents 65% of Forsyth County's population.
