

FREQUENT City Code Violations ...at a GLANCE!



Interior furniture used outdoors on porches, patios, etc. can be unsanitary and a breeding source for pests and molds. *Sec 62-2 (7)*



Vehicles left on City streets longer than 7 days (2 days on major thoroughfares) are considered abandoned. *Sec 42-342 (a)*



Clean-up behind your outside animals daily. Place manure in a watertight, fly proof container with a tight fitting lid. *Sec 6-12 (a)*



Keep your yard free of litter, garbage, rubbish, trash, yard waste, lumber, junk, old appliances, old furniture, tires, barrels etc. at all times. *Sec 26-10 (j); Sec 26-6(g)*



It is unlawful to allow grass, ground cover and weeds to grow unchecked and exceed 8 inches in height. *Sec 62-2 (c)*



Chickens, pigeons or other fowl must be contained within an adequate fence and housed within an appropriate shelter. It is unlawful to place the shelter within 150 feet of the property line, unless a special use permit has been obtained. *Sec 6-4 (a, b)*



Remove all unused vehicles. Sitting vehicles can be a breeding source, contamination from petroleum products, and a hazard to children. *Sec 42-342 (b)*



Do not place, leave or allow the accumulation of leaves, grass clipping, or any other debris from your premises on a public street. *Sec 26-10 (a)*



NOTE: Bulky items such as carpet, appliances, furniture, mattresses, etc., will be picked up by the city crews only during your annual neighborhood area cleanup, scheduled between March and August. For questions regarding bulky item collection, call 727-8000. Also, inquire about how to receive your landfill permit, valid for 2 free trips per year.
