




Winston-Salem Youth Expression Wall

Who supervises the project?

The Youth Expression Wall is a project of the Winston-Salem Youth Advisory Council (YAC). The City of Winston-Salem Human Relations Department, which serves as staff liaison to the Youth Advisory Council, supervises the administration of the project.

What is the Youth Advisory Council?

As established by the City Council, the Youth Advisory Council's mission is to serve as a conduit between city government and their younger constituents. Their core focus includes youth civic engagement through community programming, youth-oriented activities, contributing at least 40 volunteer hours per school year to government-related initiatives, projects, and programs, providing information to the community regarding topics that are important and relevant to the youth in our community, and to advise the City Council and the Human Relations Department on matters that relate to the community's youth population.

The Winston-Salem Recreation and Parks Commission has a strong history of supporting the Youth Advisory Council, and the two share a cooperative relationship.

The Youth Advisory Council dedicated the first painting in June of 2011 to the memory of high school students who have passed away.
