
Winston-Salem Statistics 2007

- ❑ One Motor Vehicle Theft every 7.5 hours

- ❑ Cars are the number one target, as compared to trucks, buses, and motorcycles




Common methods

- Bump and Grab
- Parking Lot Surprise
- Stop Sign or Stop Light
- Distraction
- Forced Over on Roadway
- Blue Light Bandit




Prevention

- Be alert to surroundings
- Never exit your car for strangers
- Keep your doors locked at all times
- Avoid Isolated areas
- Stay on main roads
- Carry a cell-phone
- Your car is faster than your feet



Stopping for Blue Light

- When stopping for a blue light, choose a well-lighted area
 - Look for more than one blue light
 - Check for flashing lights
 - Listen for Siren
 - Look for Uniform
 - Stay in your car
 - Turn on interior light
 - Activate emergency flashers
